## **WOODLAND PARK MAN ARRESTED FOR SEXUAL CONDUCT WITH CHILDREN**

WOODLAND PARK, NEW JERSEY: September 21, 2009

On Friday, September 18, 2009, The Passaic County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit arrested Eduardo M. Saez. Mr. Saez, a 61-year-old man residing in Woodland Park, New Jersey, was charged with the sexual abuse of four children ranging in age from 6 through 14. The complaints allege one count of Sexual Assault (Second Degree), two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Second Degree), two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child (Third Degree) and one count of Criminal Sexual Contact (Fourth Degree). The second degree charges each carry a maximum sentence of up to 10 years in the New Jersey State Prison. The third degree charges carry a maximum sentence of up to five years in the New Jersey State Prison. The fourth degree offense carries a maximum sentence of up to 18 months in the New Jersey State Prison. The Passaic County Prosecutor's Special Victims Unit, the Passaic County Prosecutor's Computer Services Unit and the Woodland Park Police Department investigated the case jointly.

Mr. Saez is being held in the Passaic County Jail in lieu of \$200,000.00 bail, is prohibited from contact with the victims, is prohibited from contact with children less than 16, and must surrender all his travel documents.

A criminal indictment is merely an accusation. Despite this accusation, the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
