WANAQUE MAN ARRESTED FOR CAR FIRE IN RINGWOOD

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes, Ringwood Police Chief Bernard Lombardo and Wanaque Police Chief John Reno announced the arrest today of 20 year old Frank P. Segreto of Wanaque, New Jersey. Mr. Segreto has been charged with setting fire to a car in Ringwood, New Jersey, on November 6, 2010. Mr. Segreto has also been charged with threatening two witnesses in this investigation.

The complaint alleges one count of aggravated arson and two counts of terroristic threats. Aggravated arson is a second degree crime and carries a maximum sentence of up to ten years in prison. Terroristic threat is a third degree crime and carries a maximum sentence of up to five years in prison.

A criminal complaint is merely an accusation. Despite this accusation, the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
