CLIFTON MAN ARRESTED FOR SEXUAL ASSAULT OF CHILD

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes announces the arrest today of Curtis Bouier, a 39 year-old Clifton, New Jersey resident. Mr. Bouier is currently employed as a City of Paterson firefighter. He was charged with first degree aggravated sexual assault, second-degree sexual assault and second-degree endangering the welfare of a minor, for allegedly sexually assaulting a family friend when she was 11 years-old. Aggravated sexual assault carries a maximum term of imprisonment of twenty years with 85% of that sentence to be served before parole; sexual assault carries a maximum term of ten years with 85% of the sentence to be served before parole and endangering the welfare of a child carries a maximum term of ten years. Mr. Bouier's bail was set at \$250,000 by the Honorable Raymond A.

Reddin. He is further prohibited from any contact with the alleged victim.
