JOE GIUDICE ARRESTED FOR FRAUDULENT DRIVER'S LICENSE

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes announces that on March 25, 2011, members of the Passaic County Prosecutor's Office Financial Crimes Unit assisted by the Montville Township Police Department arrested Giuseppe Giudice a/k/a Joe Giudice, Towaco, New Jersey, age 40 for fraudulently obtaining a New Jersey driver's license. Giudice was arrested at his home. Bail has been set by Paterson Municipal Court at \$50,000.

These Complaints allege that in June 2010, Giudice obtained a driver's license at the Paterson, New Jersey Motor Vehicle Office using his brother's identifying information. Joe Giudice's legitimate driver's license was suspended at the time and is currently suspended.

Giudice is charged with Wrongfully Using Identifying Information of Another, a violation of NJSA2C:21-17.2, a crime of the second degree, which is punishable by up to ten years in State prison, and Forgery, a violation of NJSA 2C:21-(a), a crime of the fourth degree punishable by up to eighteen months in State Prison.

The charges arise out of an investigation conducted by the Financial Crimes Unit of the Passaic County Prosecutor's Office with assistance of investigators from the Motor Vehicle Commission.
