PASSAIC VALLEY REGIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER ARRESTED FOR SEXUAL CONDUCT WITH STUDENT

WAYNE, NEW JERSEY:

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes announces the arrest of 32 year-old Kyle S. Daniw. Mr. Daniw was arrested at his Wayne, New Jersey home this morning. Daniw was employed as a Passaic Valley Regional High School teacher. Daniw also coached basketball, track, and cross-country at the school. He was charged with second-degree Endangering the Welfare of a Child, for engaging in sexual conduct with a sixteen-year-old female student beginning in her sophomore year. The alleged victim was a student in Mr. Daniw's freshman history class. Daniw later supervised her as she participated in various school related sports activities. Endangering the Welfare of a Child carries a maximum term of ten years in New Jersey State prison. Mr. Daniw's bail has been set at \$40,000. He has been suspended from his position at Passaic Valley Regional High School.
