## TWO PEDESTRIANS STRUCK IN PATERSON

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

April 18, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that on Wednesday April 17, 2019 at approximately 4:42 p.m., officers responded to Church Street near the intersection of Broadway, in the City of Paterson in response to a report of a two pedestrians struck by a motor vehicle. A 2013 Toyota Prius, collided with two pedestrians who were not in a crosswalk. The driver remained at the scene. Both pedestrians were transported to Saint Joseph's University Hospital for treatment. Edwin Gonzalez, 62 years old of Paterson was treated for minor injuries. Guillermo Gonzalez, 65 years old, also of Paterson remains at the hospital, being treated for serious injuries.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
