CLIFTON MAN KILLED IN EARLY MORNING CRASH

CLIFTON, NEW JERSEY:

October 19, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Clifton Police Chief Mark Centurione announce that at approximately 2:49 a.m., on Saturday October 19, 2019, police responded to the intersection of Route 21 and Exit 14 in the City of Clifton where a single vehicle had crashed. A 2007 Audi A4, being operated by thirty-eight (38) year old Franklin Cedeno, of Clifton, New Jersey, failed to negotiate the exit ramp. As a result of the crash Mr. Cedeno was pronounced deceased on scene.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
