INFORMATION SOUGHT FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING ROUTE 3 CRASH INVESTIGATION THAT LEFT TWO SERIOUSLY INJURED

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

August 26, 2020

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Clifton Police Chief Thomas Rinaldi announce that investigators are seeking the assistance of the public regarding any witnesses to a crash that occurred at approximately 10:07 a.m., on Tuesday August 25, 2020. On that date, and at that time, police responded to the area of Route 3 Westbound and Allwood Road, in the City of Clifton on a report of a multi-vehicle crash. A 2005 Mack Conventional Cab dump truck, being operated by forty year old Chad Hines, of Wantage, New Jersey, struck a 2019 Honda Civic driven by a twenty-five year old female Clifton resident who along with a minor passenger were transported to Saint Joseph's University Medical Center. After the initial collision, the Mack dump truck struck a 2013 Subaru Outback, being operated by a fifty-four year old male Nutley, resident and the Honda Civic struck a 2020 Chevrolet Traverse, being operated by a thirty- five year old male Nutley, resident. No other parties were injured.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
