NON-FATAL STABBING VICTIM LOCATED IN CLIFTON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Clifton Police Chief Mark P. Centurione announce that at approximately 12:31 a.m. on May 4, 2019, members of the Clifton Police Department responded to a business located in the area of Main Avenue Clifton, NJ on a report of a party who had been stabbed. Upon arrival the police located a 34-year-old Passaic Resident who had been stabbed multiple times. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment and is in critical condition. At this time no crime scene has been located.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
