SHOOTING IN AREA OF 44 MACDONALD STREET IN CLIFTON, NJ

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Clifton Police Chief Mark P. Centurione announce that at approximately 7:06 p.m. on May 29, 2019, members of the Clifton Police Department responded to a residence located in the area of 44 MacDonald Street, Clifton, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located an 18-year-old Clifton Resident who had sustained a gunshot wound to his leg. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
