SHOOTING IN AREA OF BELMONT AVENUE AND NORTH 10th STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

JULY 28, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately, 10:51 p.m. on July 27, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Belmont Avenue and North 10th Street on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival the police located a 20-year-old male Paterson resident, a 21-year-old male Paterson resident, and a 20-year-old male Paterson resident who had sustained non-fatal gunshot wounds. All three victims were immediately transported to St Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
