SHOOTING IN AREA OF EAST 26th STREET AND 10th AVENUE PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

JUNE 22, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 12:52, a.m. on June 22, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of East 26th Street and 10th Avenue Paterson, NJ on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival the police located evidence of a crime scene, but no victim was located. A short time later members of the Paterson Police Department were advised that a 21-year-old male Paterson resident had arrived at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson seeking treatment for a non-fatal gunshot wound.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
