SHOOTING IN AREA OF GODWIN AVENUE AND SUMMER STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

APRIL 4, 2021

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 12:09 a.m. on April 4, 2021, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to the area of Broadway and Summer Street in Paterson, New Jersey on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival members of the Paterson Police Department located a 20-year-old male Paterson resident who sustained multiple non-fatal gunshot wounds. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's University Medical Center in Paterson, New Jersey for treatment. A short time later members of the Paterson Police Department were advised a 20-year-old male Haledon, New Jersey resident arrived at Saint Joseph's University Medical Center in Paterson, New Jersey seeking treatment for a non-fatal gunshot wound.

Based on the preliminary investigation it is believed the victims were in the area of Godwin Avenue and Summer Street in Paterson, New Jersey when the shooting occurred

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
