SHOOTING IN AREA OF NORTH MAIN AND JEFFERSON STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

June 29, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 10:50, p.m. on June 28, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of North Main and Jefferson Street Paterson, NJ on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival the police located a 42-year-old female Paterson resident, a 25-year-old male Paterson resident, and a 46-year-old male Paterson resident in the area of North Main and Jefferson Street Paterson, NJ. The victims were immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of non-fatal gunshot wounds. A short time later members of the Paterson Police Department were advised that a 53-year-old male Paterson resident arrived at Saint Joseph's Medical Center in Paterson for treatment of a non-fatal gunshot wound.

Based on the initial investigation a potential crime scene was located in the area of North Main and Jefferson Street Paterson, NJ. The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
