SHOOTING IN AREA OF ROSA PARKS BOULEVARD AND GOVERNOR STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

APRIL 11, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 4:44, p.m. on April 11, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Rosa Parks Boulevard and Governor Street Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located a 30-year-old male Paterson resident and a 32-year-old male Paterson resident near the intersection of Rosa Parks Boulevard and Governor Street. Both victims had sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound and were immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
