## SHOOTING IN AREA OF ROSA PARKS BOULEVARD PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

MAY 24, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 11:30, p.m. on May 23, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Rosa Parks Boulevard Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located evidence of a crime scene, but no victim was located. A short time later members of the Paterson Police Department were advised that a 23-year-old male Paterson resident had arrived at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson seeking treatment for non-fatal gunshot wounds.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
