SHOOTING IN AREA OF UNION AVENUE AND JASPER STREET PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

JULY 29, 2018

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 4:33, a.m. on July 29, 2018, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Redwood Avenue Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. Upon arrival the police located a 31-year-old male Paterson resident and a 28 year-old-male Paterson resident at the corner of Union Avenue and Jasper Street who had both sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound. The victims were immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
