SHOOTING IN AREA OF WASHINGTON AVENUE AND SPRING STREET PATERSON, NJ

NOVEMBER 14, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 8:02, p.m. on November 14, 2019, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Washington Avenue and Spring Street Paterson, NJ on a report of shots fired. While responding to the area, the police were advised that a 20-year-old male Paterson resident arrived at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson seeking treatment for a non-fatal gunshot wound.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
