FATAL SHOOTING IN AREA OF 1 CIRCLE AVENUE IN PATERSON, NEW JERSEY

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

April 11, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that approximately 3:34 p.m. this afternoon, members of the Paterson Police Department and the Passaic County Prosecutor's Office responded to the area of 1 Circle Avenue in Paterson, New Jersey on a report of shots fired. Two male victims were located, a 21 year old male from Paterson sustained non-fatal gunshot wounds, and a 24 year old male, also from Paterson, sustained fatal gunshot wounds. Both males were transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson, where they were both treated. The 24 year old male victim was pronounced at approximately 4:00 p.m.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
