UPDATE-VICTIM IDENTIFIED IN THE AUGUST 4, 2019 HOMICIDE WHICH OCCURRED IN THE AREA OF 271 SUMMER STREET IN THE CITY OF PATERSON

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

August 6, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 10:20 p.m. on Sunday, August 4, 2019, police officers responded to the area of 271 Summer Street in the City of Paterson in response to a report of shots fired. Upon their arrival, the officers discovered the victim, Kevin Lewis, 28 years old from Paterson, unresponsive having suffered multiple gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to St. Joseph's University Medical Center in Paterson, where he was immediately rushed into surgery. A short time later, Mr. Lewis died from his wounds and was pronounced deceased at approximately 5:15 a.m.

This investigation is active and ongoing. More information will be released when it becomes available.
