## PEDESTRIAN STRUCK AND KILLED IN MORRISTOWN

---

MORRISTOWN, NEW JERSEY:

June 8, 2019

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes announces that at approximately 2:12 p.m., on Friday, June 7, 2019, police responded to the intersection of Schuyler Place and Ann Street in the town of Morristown in response to a motor vehicle collision involving a pedestrian. The driver, Lt. Kristi Allegretta of the Morris County Prosecutor's Office, was operating a County owned Ford Explorer turning left off of Schuyler Place onto Ann Street. At that time she struck a pedestrian who was attempting to cross Ann Street. The pedestrian, identified as eighty (80) year old Galina Kustanovich of Morristown, suffered serious injuries and was transported to Morristown Medical Center, where she succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced deceased at approximately 9:30 p.m.. Lt. Allegretta suffered no injuries and there were no other passengers in the vehicle at the time.

The investigation, which is active and ongoing, is being conducted by the Passaic County Prosecutors Office at the Direction of the Division of Criminal Justice with the assistance of the Morristown Police Department. More information will be released once it becomes available.
