OVER 100 RESIDENTS DISPLACED BY FIRE ON GREGORY AVENUE IN PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY

April 15, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Chief Patrick Trentacost, of the Passaic Fire Department, announce that at approximately 1:00 p.m. on this date, April 15, 2017, a fire in a residential, four-story, 46-unit apartment building, located at 112 Gregory Avenue in Passaic, New Jersey, caused over 100 residents of the building to be displaced. The investigation reveals that all building residents have been accounted for, and no injuries are reported.

At this time, the cause of the fire is undetermined. This investigation is ongoing.
