## **SHOOTING IN AREA OF ROSA PARKS BLVD AND KEEN STREET PATERSON, NJ**

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

November 30, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 6:49 p.m. on November 29, 2017, members of the Paterson Police Department were dispatched to 72 Rosa Parks Boulevard Paterson, NJ on a reported shooting. Upon arrival police located a 20-year-old male Paterson resident, who sustained a non-fatal gunshot wound. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson for treatment. Based on the initial investigation, the victim was in the area of Rosa Parks Boulevard and Keen Street when he was shot.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
