## SHOOTING IN AREA OF JASPER STREET AND TOTOWA AVENUE PATERSON, NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

November 13, 2017

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Deputy Paterson Police Chief Ibrahim Baycora announce that at approximately 4:20 p.m. on November 13, 2017, members of the Paterson Police Department responded to the area of Jasper Street and Totowa Avenue, Paterson, NJ on multiple reports of shots fired. Upon arrival they located a 30-year-old male Paterson resident suffering from a non-fatal gunshot wound. The victim was immediately transported to Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center for treatment.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
