SHOOTING IN AREA OF GODWIN AVENUE AND SUMMER STREET PATERSON NJ

PATERSON, NEW JERSEY:

May 11, 2018

Passaic County Prosecutor Camelia M. Valdes and Paterson Police Chief Troy Oswald announce that at approximately 5:08, p.m. on May 11, 2018, members of the Paterson Police Department were advised that a 30-year old male from Paterson, NJ was seeking treatment for non-fatal gunshot wounds at Saint Joseph's Regional Medical Center in Paterson.

Based on the initial investigation, the victim was in the area of Godwin Avenue and Summer Street when he was carjacked by three males.

The investigation remains active and ongoing. More information will be released once it becomes available.
